<i>Honey, pineapple, almonds, toast. North facing vineyards maintain freshness, but with a distinctly tropical finish</i>	
MUSCADET de Sèvre et Maine 'sur lie' 2018/19, A.Bonhomme, Loire, Melon de Bourgogne 12%	31.00
<i>Fine, dry, refreshing, bracing Atlantic influences make this wine one of the all-time greats with seafood</i>	
TOURAIN SAUVIGNON 2019, Domaine de la Bergerie, Jacky Marteau, Loire 13%	34.00
<i>Typically aromatic with a complex note of hawthorn, elderflower and boxwood – a very good alternative to Sancerre</i>	
SOAVE CLASSICO 2018, Guerrieri Rizzardi, Veneto, Italy, Gargenaga, Chardonnay, Trebbiano 12%	34.50
<i>Fresh, cool climate fruit on the nose, drink with shellfish soup, egg-based dishes, grilled fish ... even a vegetable risotto</i>	
FERRUM ALBARIÑO 2018, Bodegas As Laxas, Rias Baixas, Spain, 12.5%	36.00
<i>Clear, brilliant, straw yellow-coloured with green nuances, reminiscent of a viognier with a bit of bite</i>	
BOURGOGNE CHARDONNAY 2017, Nuiton-Beaunoy, Burgundy 13%	36.00
<i>Dry, fine, mineral. Typical Burgundian chardonnay tropical fruit flavours, with real grip and tightness on the palate</i>	
TENUTA ULISSE PECORINO 2018, Terre di Chieti IGP, Abruzzo, Italy, 13%	37.00
<i>Medium acidity, delicious tropical fruit flavours of white peach and papaya, the tiny hint of sweetness makes a great all-rounder</i>	
FUNARO PINZERI 2016, Sicily, Grillo 14%	37.00
<i>Soft citrus blossom and peach flavours. Organic. The Grillo grape thrives in Sicily's hot summers, flowery finish</i>	
MONTAGNY Tête de Cuvée 2017/18, Domaine Berthenet, Côte Chalonnais, Burgundy, Chardonnay 13%	39.00
<i>Fish, poultry, creamy dishes, goat's cheeses ... great with all these. Dry, cool climate Burgundian depth of flavour</i>	
CHABLIS 2018, Domaine Séguinot-Bordet, Chardonnay 13%	40.00
<i>Further North, cooler still, tight green flavours, freshness and creamy acidity. Essential Chablis minerality</i>

<i>Dry, perfumed, whiff of gunflint ... very typical. Hard calcareous soils together with the sauvignon grape ensure good liveliness</i>

<i>Very fine with excellent richness and minerality. Judicious use of oak gives a perfect balance</i>

ENSEDUNE MALBEC 2018, IGP Coteaux d'Ensérune, S.W. France 13.5% <i>Unoaked, with fresh, vivid soft berry fruits and floral flavours. A winner with all meat dishes</i>	27.00
ANJOU ROUGE 2016, Domaine de la Treille, Gabriel Taillée, Loire, Cabernet Franc 12.5% <i>Fresh red fruit flavours on the nose, green and vegetal flavours add crispness and raciness</i>	27.50
LE VERSANT CABERNET-SAUVIGNON 2017, IDP Pays d'Oc, S.W. France 13.5% <i>Powerful aromas and gentle on the palate, strawberries, sweet peppers and eucalyptus ... another red meat wine</i>	28.00
LA VIGIE 2014, Corbières Cru Boutenac, Languedoc, Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre, Carignan 14% <i>Distinctly rich and herb-scented, the vines have to dig deep in typically arid countryside ... which gives real 'goût de terroir'</i>	30.00
GAMAY DE TOURAINE 2017, Domaine Desloges, Loire 12.5% <i>Uncomplicated and packed with juicy flavour, a great lunchtime red, even better in a bit of sunshine ... light on its feet</i>	31.00
CÔTES du RHÔNE 'Le Perussier' 2017, Domaine Plantevin, Southern Rhône, Grenache, Syrah 14% <i>Firm but soft tannins, slight cocoa finish, an area with very warm days but cool nights, ideal conditions</i>	34.00
BOURGUEIL 2016/17, Domaine des Mailloches, Cuvée Vieilles Vignes, Loire, Cab. Franc 12.5% <i>Loire reds are the subject of a bit of a revival – very typically crunchy cracked pepper aromas, cassis fruit flavours. Light but gripping</i>	35.00
BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR 2017/18, Nuiton-Beaunoy, Burgundy 13% <i>Cedarwood on the nose, earthy ripe cranberry and redcurrant fruit flavours, attractive creaminess on the finish. Good pinot noir</i>	37.00
CHÂTEAU DES DEMOISELLES 2015, Castillon, Côtes de Bordeaux, Merlot, Cab. Sauvignon 14% <i>Big, weighty and unashamedly wood-dominated, opens up well in the glass and finishes long. Impressive</i>	37.00
AUNTSFIELD Estate Single Vineyard Pinot Noir 2017, Marlborough, New Zealand, Pinot Noir 14% <i>A whiff of mint on the nose, spicy tannins, silky mouthfeel, briary black raspberry and herby flavours, spicy</i>	41.00
CHÂTEAU PATACHE D'AUX 2014, Cru Bourgeois, Médoc, Cab. Sauvignon, Cab. Franc, Merlot, Bordeaux 13% <i>Aged in 30% new oak, giving an attractive, spicy, vanilla nose and blackcurrant fruitiness. A much-loved claret</i>	42.00
CROZES-HERMITAGE Signature 2015/16, Domaine Michelas St. Jemms, Northern Rhône, Syrah 14% <i>Spicy blackberry nose, blueberries and plums on the palate, mint and pepper on the aftertaste. One of my most favourite</i>	42.00
ROSSO DI MONTALCINO DOC 2016, Castello Tricerchi, Italy, Sangiovese 14% <i>Herbaceous on the nose, black cherry and wild berry fruit flavours in the mouth, a junior partner to the famous Brunello</i>	42.00
MERCUREY 2016, Domaine du Meix-Foulot, Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy, Pinot Noir 13% <i>Silky, earthy pinot noir flavours; lightness of touch, a degree of Burgundian opulence gives a delicious finish</i>	44.00
SAVIGNY-LÈS-BEAUNE 2015/16, Domaine Jean-Jacques Girard, Burgundy, Pinot Noir 13% <i>Gloriously aromatic, fruity and distinctly Burgundian, quite explosive fruit with purity and elegance. Smooth, supple</i>	48.00
CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE TÉLÉGRAMME 2017, Famille Brunier, S. Rhône, Grenache, Syrah, Mourvedre 14.5% <i>Soft spicy fruit, mouth-filling, long and ripe in the mouth, the second wine of the famous Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe</i>	55.00
